

**GIRL SCOUTS – WILDERNESS ROAD COUNCIL
FAYETTE/JESSAMINE COUNTY DAY CAMP 2008
BUGS AND OTHER CREEPY CRAWLIES**

LOCATION:

Camp Shawano is 13 miles south of Lexington off Tates Creek Road. Directions will be sent after close of registration.

TIMES:

Sessions I and II run from 9:30 to 3:15. Arrive at camp between 9:15 and 9:30 and in the afternoon between 3:00 and 3:15. We use ONE-WAY traffic in and out. No one may leave camp before 9:30. Be prepared to spend a few minutes in camp. Those who have paid for extended day services must be out of the camp before 8:45. We suggest you form car pools. The Girl Scouts-Wilderness Road Council will not be responsible for the safety of children whose parents do not pick them up promptly at the appointed time. Sessions I and II have special units for the boys and younger girls of the staff. They will enjoy the same program as regular campers according to their ages. Pixies (girls and boys ages 2-5) must be toilet trained. Boys unit is for boys 6-11 years old.

EXTENDED DAY SERVICES ARE AVAILABLE FOR SESSIONS I AND II. Campers may be dropped off at camp between 8:00 and 8:45 a.m. and picked up between 3:45 and 6:00. The fee for extended day services is an extra \$25/week. Please complete the extended day section on the registration form.

Mom & Me Session runs from 6:00 pm Friday to 12:00 pm Sunday and participants stay in one unit in the camp.

STAFF:

Unit Leaders: The Fayette-Jessamine Day Camp is run entirely by UNPAID VOLUNTEERS. Volunteers are scout leaders, mothers and friends. Staff training will be held at Camp Shawano. Session I training will be May 31, 9:00 am to 5:00 pm. Session II training will be May 30, 6:00 pm to May 31, 5:00 pm. A staff volunteer's first child attends day camp for free provided the volunteer works the entire session. Each additional child pays only \$10. We cannot have camp without a staff. Please complete the staff registration form and join us this summer.

Seniors: Seniors may earn hours toward the Senior Leadership Award by serving as an assistant unit leader. Girls must have completed 9th grade, attend staff training, and complete the Girl Application/T-shirt information form. NO FEE.

Program Aide Cadettes: PA training preferred. This position is open to girls registered as a Cadette in 2007-2008 and who have completed 7th grade. Upon successful participation in this unit, they will earn hours toward Cadette Leadership Award. Girls must attend staff training (unless excused by the session director) and complete the Girl Application/T-shirt information form. NO FEE. *Girls must work the entire session to receive the T-shirt at no charge.*

All Seniors and Program Aide Cadettes must turn in a physician-completed health form before the start of camp.

REGISTRATION:

Girls must register as individuals and complete a separate registration form for each session. ONLY ONE CAMPER PER FORM WILL BE ACCEPTED (except the Mom & Me session). If you need additional registration forms, please make copies or you can get additional forms at www.gswrc.org.

Deadline: May 10. The number of girls accepted depends on how many volunteer unit leaders we have.

Camperships: Financial aid applications are available from the council office and should be turned in with the registration.

Checks: Make check payable to GS-WRC. Checks must be included with registration form(s).

Cookie Dollars: Mail registration as soon as possible. Cookie dollars may be mailed at a later time, but must be received before the session starts.

Refunds: Refunds are made only if illness is certified by a doctor.

T-shirts: Day Camp T-shirts are included in the camp fee for Sessions I and II. Staff pays \$6 (see T-shirt section on staff form). Mom & Me participants pay an additional \$6 for T-shirts. The T-shirt is the same for all sessions so if you plan to attend more than one session, it is not necessary to order a camp T-shirt with each session. If you are in doubt of sizing, order up. T-shirts are pre-ordered, so we cannot make exchanges. We cannot guarantee a T-shirt if you register past the deadline.

SESSION I - Monday, June 16 – Friday, June 20
Directed by: Cathy Feltham, Charlene Pennington, Jodi Garrison and Willow Cooper

Brownie Unit - \$55: for Brownies who have completed 1st and 2nd grades. Girls will enjoy outdoor activities, arts and crafts, and an overnight on Thursday.
Fly-Up Unit - \$55: for Brownies who have completed 3rd grade. Girls will work on Junior badges and general camp activities, with an overnight on Thursday.
Junior Unit - \$55: for Juniors that have completed the 4th and 5th grades. Girls will work on Junior badges and general camp activities, with an overnight on Thursday.
Advanced Junior Unit - \$60: for Juniors who have completed 5th and 6th grades and have previous day camp experience. Girls will enjoy advanced camp activities, with overnights on Tuesday and Thursday.
Boys/Pixies Unit - \$10: this unit is ONLY for staff children. Pixies (girls and boys, ages 2-5) must be toilet trained. Boys unit (ages 6-11) will enjoy the same program as regular campers according to their ages.

Brownie Unit - \$55: for Brownies who have completed 1st and 2nd grades. Girls will enjoy outdoor activities, arts and crafts, and an overnight on Wednesday.
Fly-Up Unit - \$55: for Brownies who have completed 3rd grade. Girls will work on Junior badges and general camp activities, with an overnight on Wednesday.
Junior Unit - \$55: for Juniors that have completed the 4th and 5th grades. Girls will work on Junior badges and general camp activities, with an overnight on Wednesday.
Boys/Pixies Unit - \$10: this unit is ONLY for staff children. Pixies (girls and boys, ages 2-5) must be toilet trained. Boys unit (ages 6-11) will enjoy the same program as regular campers according to their ages.
